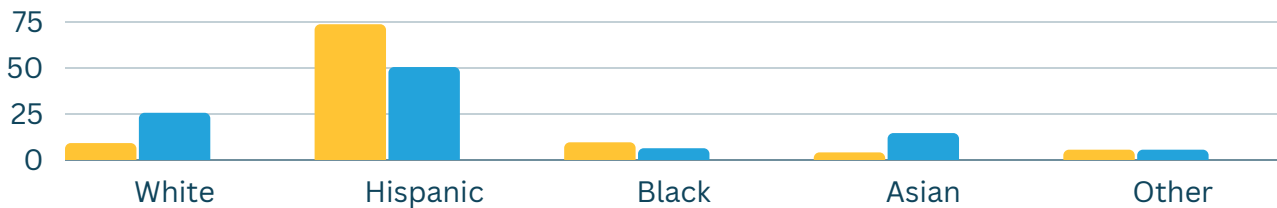

The overall crime rate in West Fresno is 69% higher than the national average.

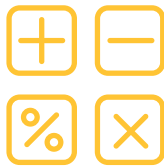

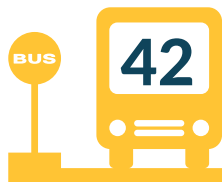

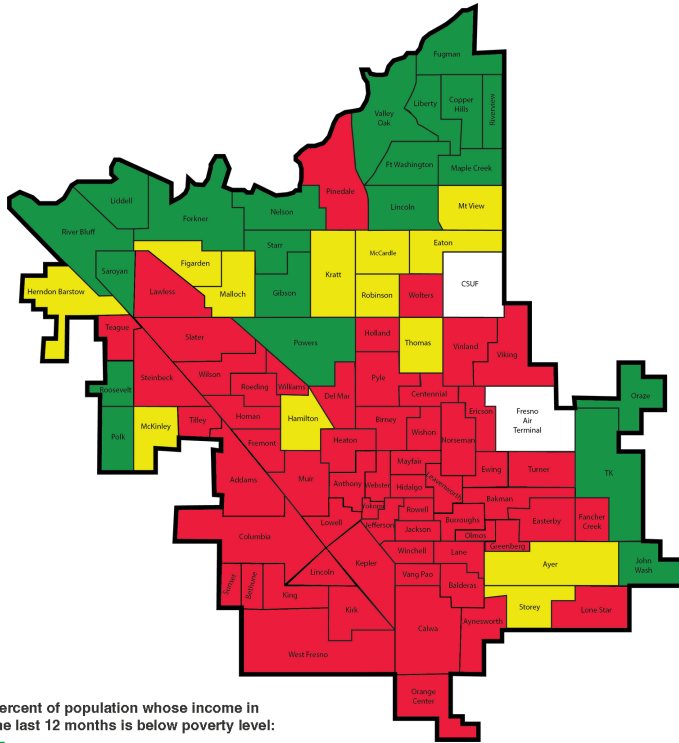

Fresno Concentration of Poverty

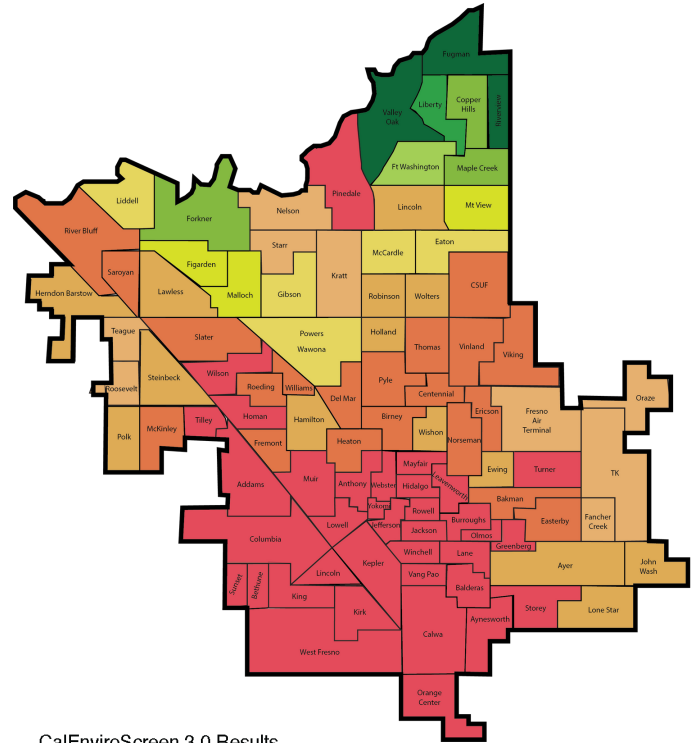


Percent of population whose income in the last 12 months is below poverty level:

Fresno Health Score

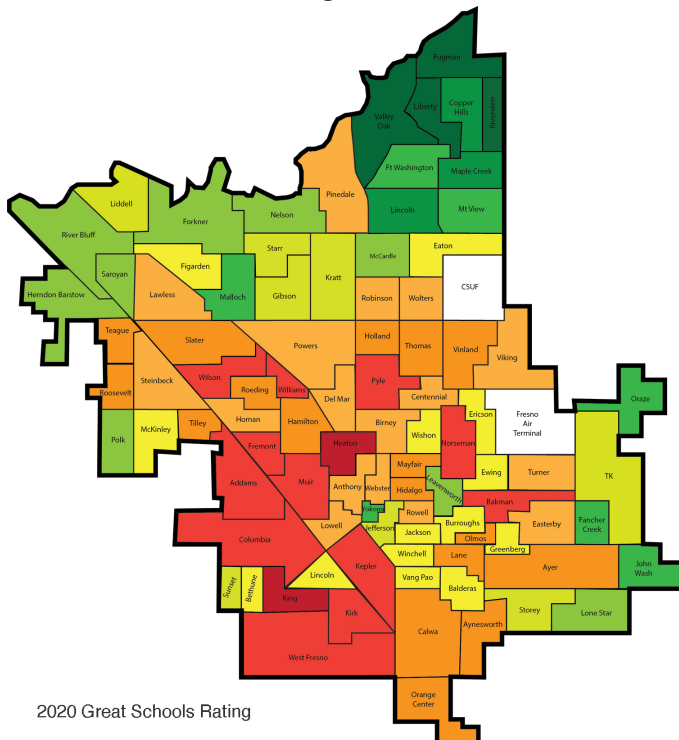


CalEnviroScreen 3.0 Results

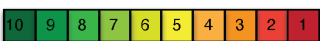


Healthiest Average Unhealthiest
