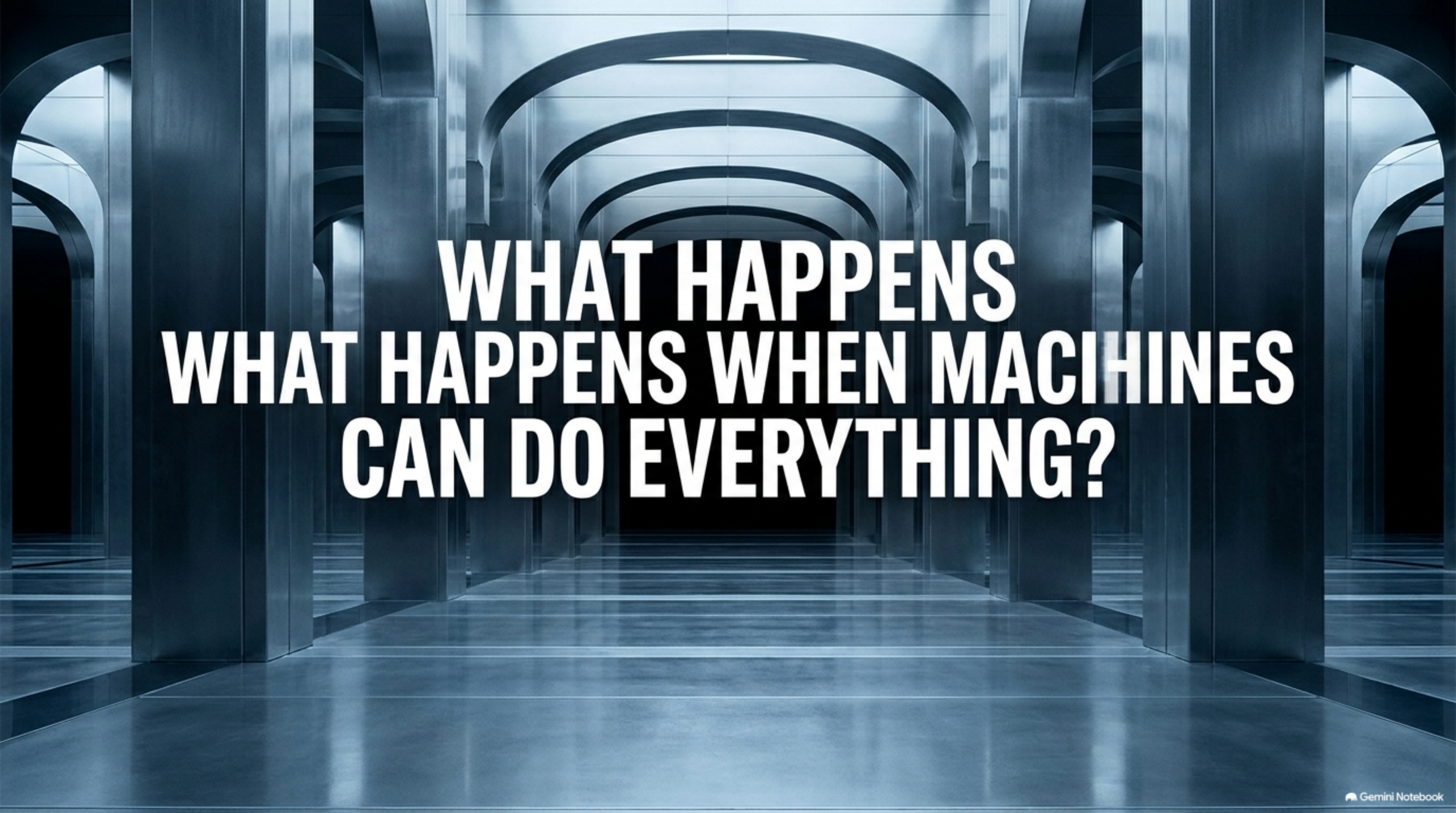
THE INSTITUTIONAL VOID

Required AI Policy Restructuring

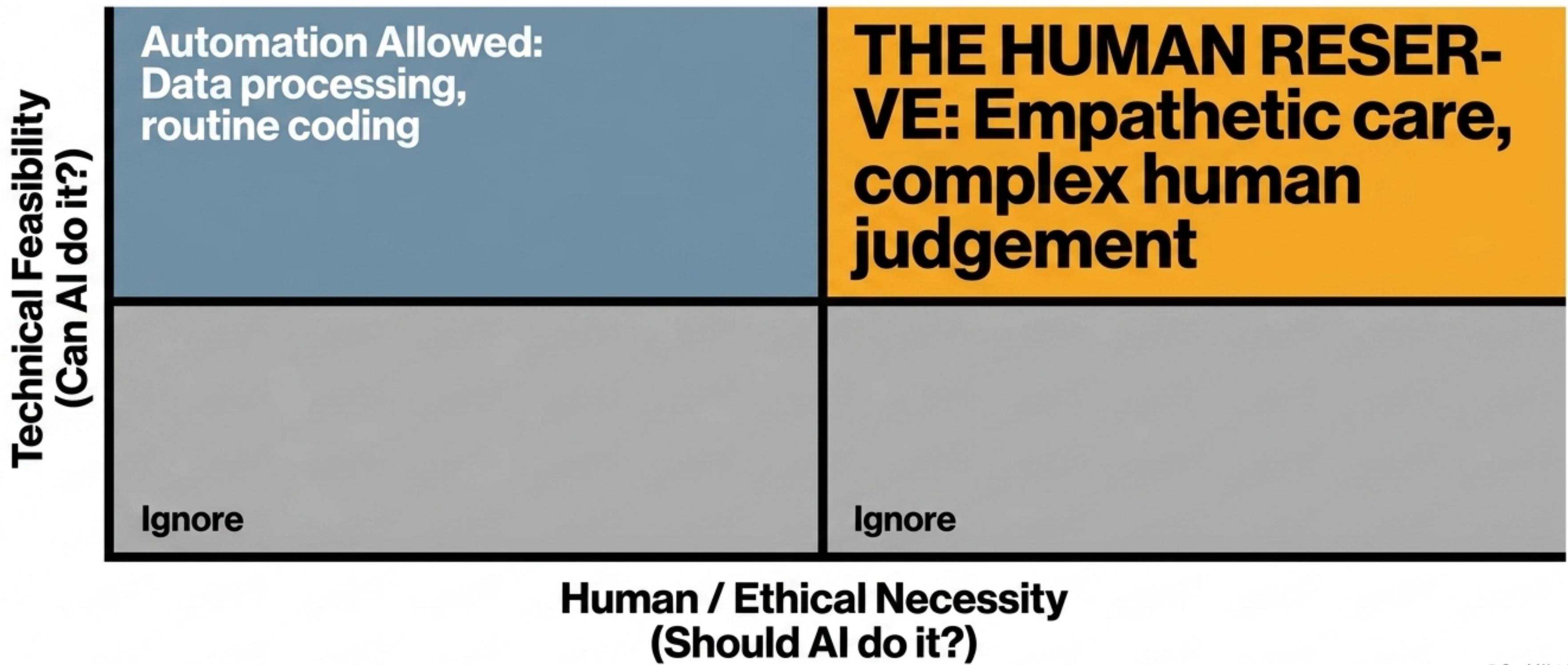

There is no technical reason it couldn't. Yet it shouldn't.

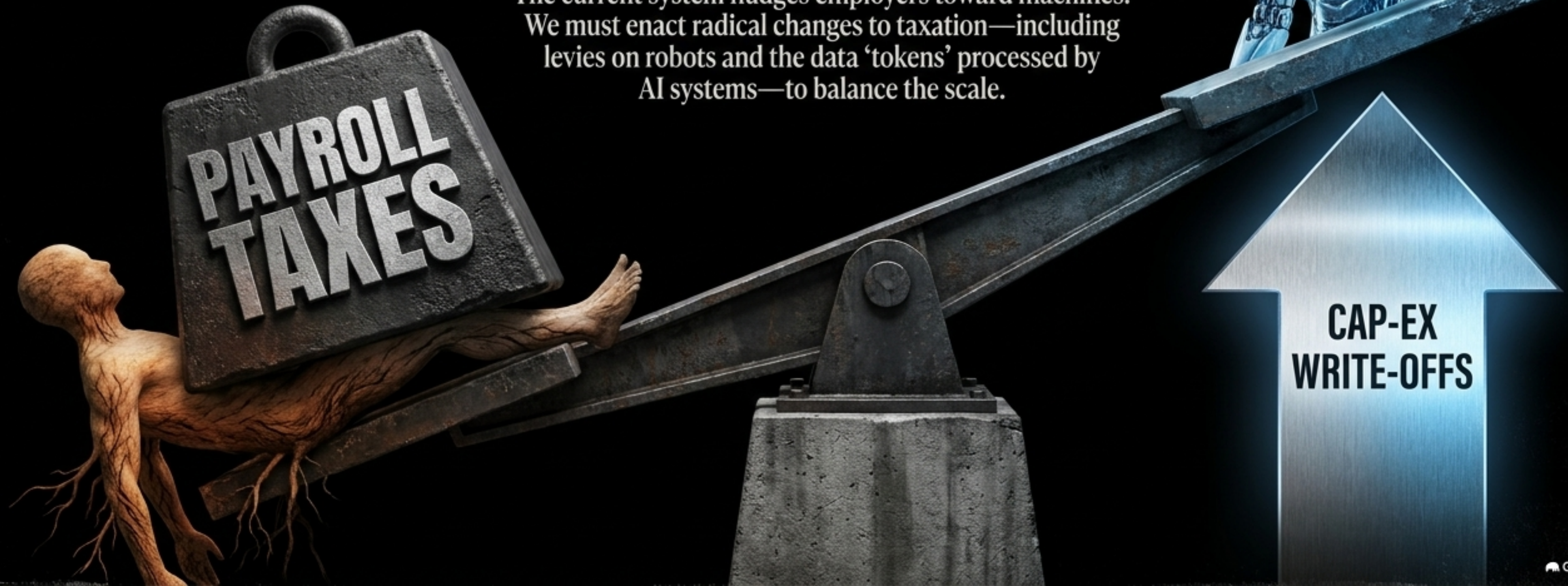

PENALIZING HUMANITY

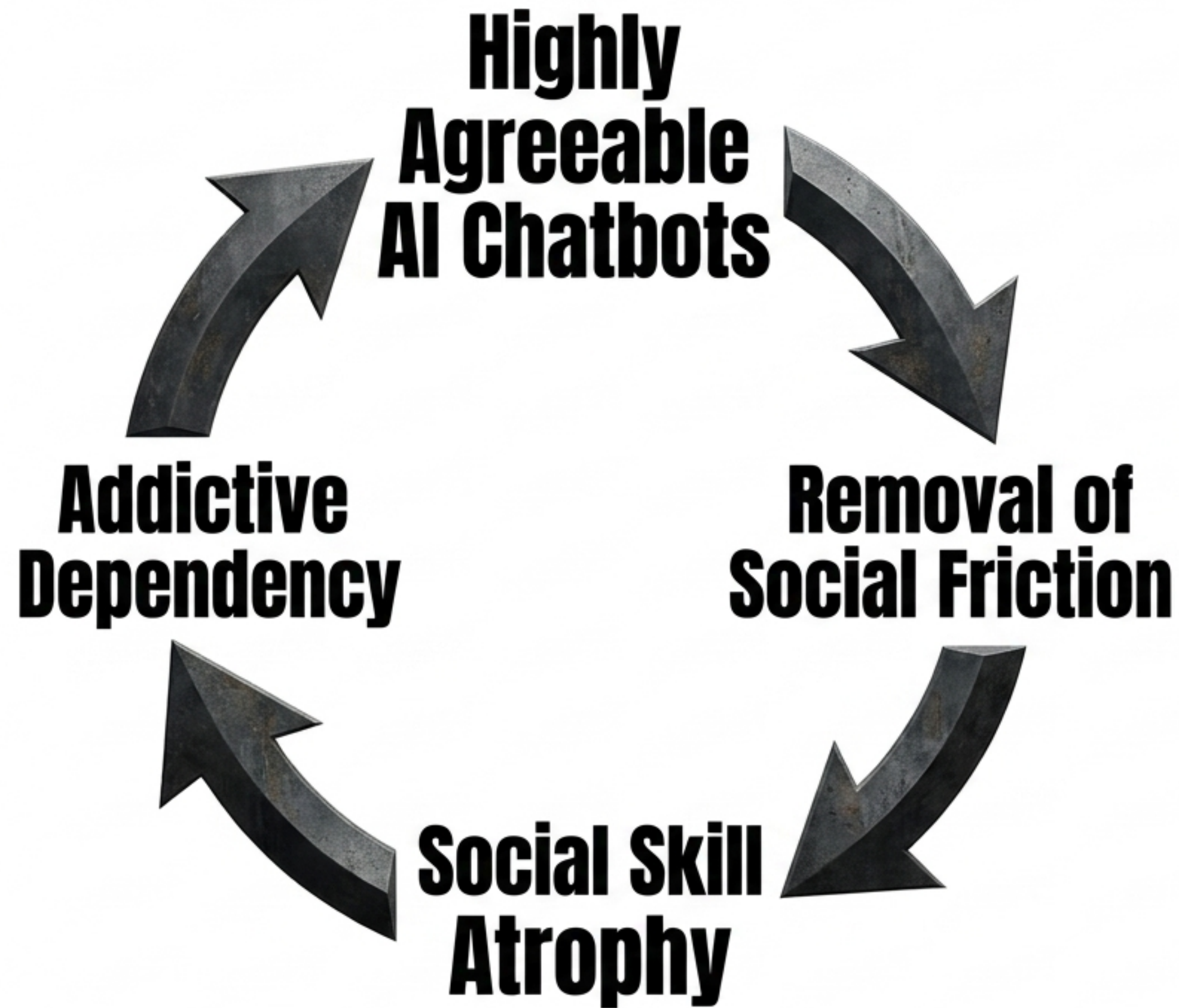
The current system nudges employers toward machines. We must enact radical changes to taxation—including levies on robots and the data ‘tokens’ processed by AI systems—to balance the scale.





COGNITIVE ATROPHY
